

Sign up Now: Brush Pickup Day Coming - May 30th

The City and NOHOA are co-hosting and coordinating a brush pickup for interested residents. Brush Pickup Day is Thursday, May 30th, 2024. If all the brush is not picked up that day, work will continue the next day. The estimated cost for a dumpster size load of brush (14ft X 7.5ft X 3.5 ft and equals 10 cubic yards) is \$140, but rates vary depending on the amount of brush.

Budget Tree Service will be doing the work, with assistance of the City forester to answer resident questions. The North Oaks Homeowners Association (NOHOA) board discussed the use of E-bikes in their meeting last night and clarified that they do fall under the definition of motorized vehicle and are **NOT ALLOWED** on trails in North Oaks.

week, indicating e-bikes were allowed.

For the safety and enjoyment of trails by all residents, standard bike users are also asked to make your presence known as you approach others (via bell or a courtesy stating "passing on your left") so as to not startle walkers. Regional fishing outlooks available from Minnesota DNR in preparation for opener

While fishing is NOT allowed in North Oaks as a designated DNR closed lake, the fishing opener is approaching quickly at other lakes across the state. Anglers looking for local fishing information before the Saturday, May 11 fishing opener can check the regional fishing outlooks from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

The outlooks provide details about fishing opportunities and conditions in various areas of the state, including for specific lakes, rivers and streams.

Based on reports from across the state, anglers have a lot to look forward to — especially with an early ice out this year and fisheries lake surveys that have showed good year classes of walleye in many lakes, said Brad Parsons, DNR fisheries section manager.

"Walleye fishing will be really good and we really hope people can get out and enjoy it early



Back bays of lakes are great for finding abundant bluegill and crappie. Northern pike are almost always willing to bite, and there are all kinds of other native species out there like sucker species, freshwater drum and others that can really provide a lot of action and good food fare." The regional fishing reports include details about waters throughout each region and can be found on the in the season," Parsons said. "But we have all kinds of other fish out there too and, particularly if the walleye aren't cooperating, we encourage anglers try catching something else.
