

- 20 years = 2.85 miles/year








## Low Pressure Vs Gravity Systems






#### **Low Pressure**



- Flexible routing
- Minimal impact on trees both in street and yards.
- Directional Drilling for most pipe installation.
- Shallower bury depth 8' vs 12'-25'
- Less impact with repairs
- Homeowners monitor maintenance.
- Individual pumping stations
- Replace pumps at 10-20+ years


## **Gravity System**



- Only major lift stations are reliant on electric power.
- Little homeowner maintenance.
- 50–75-year life
- High Capacity
- Large environmental impact on trees and yards.
- Deep digging for repairs
- High initial cost

### **Water Extension**

- Some water service areas from adjacent communities via agreements
- Fire Protection
- White Bear Lake ruling 5 miles
- St Paul Regional Water Services source water
  - Charley Lake
  - Pleasant Lake


#### What lies ahead this winter?
